Simple, Basic Steps to Follow:

- 1) Turn OFF or Unplug the Refrigeration/Freezer Unit
- 2) Remove the Cover or Gate (usually at the bottom of the unit; do not force; covers usually snap off with a gentle pull from both sides; check for screws)
- 3) Clean & Remove All Debris & Grease
- 4) Brush Coils to remove & loosen debris
- 5) Use a Hand-held Vacuum (or Compressed Air) to remove all debris inside the coils & fins
- 6) Re-attach the Cover or Gate (usually snaps back in place)
- 7) Turn ON Refrigeration/Freezer Unit
